1. Finding the Marina

Drive past Port Hamble Marina on the right
and to the barrier at the end. The security
guard will let you through the barriers.

2. Car Parking and Accessing Boats

Boat keys are held by the HYS gatehouse attendant. Pure Petrol drystack number is 32.

Advise the HYS gatehouse attendant the boat name and you will gain access to the yard (on busy weekends you may be issued with a temporary parking permit). Park as directed in the boat yard or in the carpark which is accessed on the right after the dry stack.

Pure Petrol will be berthed in the area to the right hand side of the main lifting bay. As the boat is dry stacked when not in use this is a temporary berth so you may not find the boat in exactly the same berth every time, but it will be in this area. At busy times it is necessary to raft.

If Pure Petrol is not in the water then check with HYS marina office who are open 07:00 to 19:00 during summer (office is at head of HYS main pontoon behind drystack) and they will launch ASAP. Please notify Pure Latitude should this ever occur.

3. Pure Latitude

The PL headquarters office is in Hamble at Unit 11, Hamble Yacht Services, next to Jenny's Café and upstairs. The office is open weekdays and occasional weekends. There is no requirement to visit the office but please call in if you have any questions or need any assistance or just drop by to say hello.

4. Marina Facilities

4.1 Showers, Toilets and Laundry

There is a toilet/shower block which is open 24/7. Code available from gatehouse.

4.2 Onsite Food and Drink

[Jenny's by the Boats](#) is just inside the gate, sells take away food and has a seating area outside.

[Banana Wharf](#) is the restaurant/bar in the MDL Marina between pontoons E and F.

4.3 Chandlery

There is a [Force 4 chandlery](#) opposite the Port Hamble Marina office for clothing, spares and bottled gas.

5. Fuel

The fuel berth is located at the end of Pontoon B and sells both petrol and diesel 7 days a week. Port Hamble fuel dock is operating restricted open times from 9am-5pm and importantly on an appointment basis only, with 2 slots per hour. To refuel, please contact the marina direct on 02380 452741 to book a slot that is convenient to you.

6. Local Information

6.1 Local Shops

There is a large Tesco just after the M27 junction 8 exit.

There is a small Co-operative on the High Street in Hamble Village.

6.2 Local Pubs and Restaurants

There are pubs, all of which serve food, and restaurants located a short walk away in the village. We recommend [Ye Olde White Hart](#), [King and Queen](#), [The Bugle](#) and the [River Rat](#) and [La Dolce Vita](#).

If leaving or arriving on a fast ebb or flood tide, take great care not to be swept across the fairway. Anticipate the need for significant compensation (ferry glide) when motoring cross tide.

Our main base at Port Hamble Marina places you at the heart of South Coast boating. With easy access at all states of tide to the Solent and an array of great destinations, it's easy to see why the river Hamble is widely regarded as the capital of UK boating. Cowes, Yarmouth, Lymington and Beaulieu are accessed by heading West. Portsmouth, Bembridge and Chichester to the East.
